

Radiation Protection. 233rd BSB Safety and Occupational Health (OH) Program

1. RADIATION PROTECTION:

a. The 233rd BSB will appoint a Local Radiation Protection Officer (LRPO) and alternate in writing IAW AR 11-9 and UR 385-12.

b. The LRPO must demonstrate knowledge of Federal and Army regulations and Status of Forces Agreements (SOFA) on ionizing and non-ionizing sources. Licensing and control of ionizing radiation sources are directed by Title 10CFR, Parts 19, 20, and 21, the applicable MACOM NCR Radioactive Material License, AR 11-9, UR 385-12, and the Federal Republic of Germany Ordinance on Radiation Protection. This includes:

- (1) Radiation protection responsibilities are given ample priority and channels of communications are established with tenant units storing radioactive sources.
- (2) Plans and resources exist to cope with radiation emergencies.
- (3) Inventory and storage files or records of all items within the ASG/BSB area of responsibility are on hand.
