

Dangerous Dog Owner's Permit: Payment Procedures

Each dangerous dog owner's permit is valid for two years and costs DM 150. The Hanau Office for Public Order (Ordnungsamt) will issue the permit with a billing statement that includes one of those preprinted bank transfer forms (*Überweisungsschein* in German). There are 3 ways to pay:

1. The owner can go to any German Post office and pay cash (DM). Many people use this method to pay their German Telekom bills.
2. If they bank with the Community Bank or with a German bank, owners can use the preprinted bank transfer form to have the funds transferred directly from their account to the Hanau Ordnungsamt account.
3. For owners who live in Hanau, a third option would be to go downtown to the City Cashier's office during business hours and pay in cash (DM). No checks, no credit cards.
