MEMORANDUM FOR Residents Griesheim Leased Housing Area

Subject: Pet Policy

1. The housing office has received numerous complaints that dog owners of the above leased housing area may not be complying with written policy or German law while walking their dogs. Specifically dogs walked on the path between the two housing areas. The complaint essentially states that dog owners are not cleaning up after their pets.
2. We realize that this is a common area where many people walk their pets. Our intent here is to restate the rules in order to be sure all of our residents clearly understand their responsibilities.
3. It is the responsibility of pet owners to ensure that pets are controlled in such manner that they do not become a public nuisance. Dog owners will ensure their dog is on a leash at all times when outside individual apartments. This means dogs will be on a leash when in stairwells. The person walking the pet must have the ability to control the pet. Dogs will be walked in designated pet walking areas. **Owners will not allow pets to relieve themselves on balconies, playgrounds, or within 50 feet of any family housing building, billets, medical facility, or child care facility. All fecal matter will be picked up, wrapped and disposed of in the household waste containers. This also includes pet walking areas.**
4. It must be noted that a second infraction of this nature and failure to comply with this pet policy and the Family Housing Resident Handbook could be grounds for eviction and/or loss of pet privileges.
5. It is important that we strive to maintain a healthy relationship with our German neighbors, as well as with each other. Please ensure all laws and policies are adhered to.
